Feb. 12 - In Lorain - Atlas Club 27, St. Peter's 6

Feb. 13 - Elmore Here - Elmore 14, St. Peter's 41

Feb. 20 – Lutheran Church team Elyria cancel game Birmingham Here – score 13, St. Peter's 28

Feb. 26 - In Avon Lake - Faculty team 2, St. Peter's Girls 10

Feb. 27 – Lagrange failed to appear – Boys played Amherst High 13, St. Peter's 18 Berlin Heights Girls 20, St. Peter's 1
