


Feel at home, *for* Christ Jesus is our host. If you are visiting for the first time, we are delighted to have you here!

Ponderings about St. Peter's

Did you ever wonder about how our elevator came to be? Here is part of the story.

In January 1987, 90-year-old WWI Veteran, Richard Schroeder donated \$50,000 for the church elevator. (Church Council estimated the total cost would be \$100,000.) At the time it was the largest donation ever made to St. Peter's by a living member of the church.

In 1891 Richard's grandfather helped to build St. Peter's and his father was confirmed here. At the age of 14 Richard quit school to work 10-hour days for \$1.40 an hour in the Quarries. *"Saving comes natural for me,"* Schroeder said, *"As far back as I can remember, I always saved for the future-my future. Now I am giving to the church for somebody else's future."*
