



Ponderings about St. Peter's

Easter is a special day filled with praise, thanks and memories. Today our church has been decorated with beautiful Easter Lilies and all our traditional trappings. Did you ever wonder about past Easters at St. Peter's?

Easter Sunday fell on April 22 in 1962. The church was decorated with "Easter Plants" that people wanted to bring in for the services. They were due at the church by Saturday at 1:00 p.m. so the Altar Guild could arrange them. They were to be picked up after the services.

That Sunday St. Peter's set attendance records! At the 6:30 a.m. service they had 401 and at the 10:45 a.m. service they had 599. Those receiving communion also set a record – Maundy Thursday – 240; Easter Sunday – 6:30 – 369 and 10:45 – 493.
