Ponderings about St. Peter's

With Mother's Day upon us, how many of you remember the "Mother and Daughter Banquets" held by St. Peter's? I know some of you have told me about them, so I decided to research their history.

The 1st "Mother and Daughter Banquet" was held in the basement of St. Peter's in 1923. There were 200 attendees. In 1924 the banquet was conducted by the Philathea class which was a Bible class of women that met in the church parlors on Thursday evenings. Because of a lack of room at the church the event was held in the high school auditorium (Central School). 226 ladies attended and Grandma Deuscher, as the oldest mother there, received a basket of flowers.
