Ponderings about St. Peter's

Marriage is one of the sacraments of the church. Have there been things St. Peter's has done in our past to support or recognize the importance of this? Here are some items I have discovered. In 1964 the importance of a Christian Marriage was supported by sharing some statistics with the congregation. The divorce rate in 1964 was 33%, but in Christian marriages it was 20-25%. (Today the divorce rate is around 50%.) On May 10, 1964 all the couples celebrating their 5th or multiple of 5 Wedding Anniversary were invited to the 11:00 service and were seated in a reserved section at the front of the church. I also discovered one of our minister's "Ten Commandments for a Successful Marriage":

- II. Thou Shalt Accept Each Other For What Each Other Is
- Thou Shalt Talk Things Through III.
- IV. Thou Shalt Trust One Another
