Ponderings about St. Peter's

Are you a happy person? Do you live in a happy home? The item below appeared in St. Peter's monthly newsletter in August 1929.

Six things are requisite to create a happy home. **Integrity** must be the architect, and **tidiness** the upholsterer. It must be warmed by **affection**, and lightened up with **cheerfulness**, and **industry** must be the ventilator, renewing the atmosphere and bringing in fresh salubrity (health/well-being) day by day; while overall, as a protecting canopy and glory, nothing will suffice except **the blessing of God.**
