

Ponderings about St. Peter's

At the front of the sanctuary are two flags. One is the American Flag and the other is the Christian Flag. I'm sure you learned about our country's flag in school, but do you know the story of the Christian Flag?

On September 26, 1897, when the guest speaker at a Sunday school kick-off event failed to show up, Charles C. Overton, a Sunday school superintendent stepped up to save the day. Having nothing prepared, and looking at the American flag on the stage, he began speaking about flags and their symbolism. He included in his remarks that he thought that Christians should have a flag. In 1907 Overton and Ralph Diffendorfer designed the Christian flag we have today. The colors in the flag are the same as the American flag. The white represents purity & peace; blue stands for fidelity; and red indicates Christ's blood sacrifice. There is also a pledge to the flag that was written later, which has been revised several times. See what you think of it.

"I pledge allegiance to the Christian flag, and to the Savior for whose kingdom it stands; one Savior, crucified, risen, and coming again with life and liberty to all who believe."
