CANDLE LIGHTING LITURGY: Patty Knepper

O God, we light the fourth candle of Advent. We hear Leader:

your angel Gabriel and witness the faith of Mary.

Fill us with your grace and light.

We recall the times we have struggled but overcome People: our adversity. We know times when God has filled us and our world with blessing. We remember that we have struggled, but God has given us hope and love and peace.

Mary was a young, strong, spiritual woman. Even though Leader:
