Ponderings About St. Peter's

We have been looking at the Symbols of the Twelve Apostles. So far, we have learned about St. Peter and St. John. This Sunday we will look at St. Thomas. All most of us know about him was that he was the apostle who

"doubted" and needed to touch Jesus' wounds to confirm that Christ had been resurrected. Scholars think he might have been a twin. They also point out that Thomas asked questions when the other apostles just wondered (John 14:5). Thomas also showed that he was ready to die with Christ (John 11:16). Thomas as a missionary spread the Gospel outside the Roman Empire and was the first to bring it to the Far East. Because of his work in India, he is their Patron Saint. There is no concrete proof of how he died but one account says he was stoned, shot down with arrows and then stabbed with a spear. This shield shows these symbols plus a carpenter's square because he built a church in India.
