Ponderings About St. Peter's

In the 1974 May "Key" a reference was made to the fact that St. Peter's had sent a check for \$600 to the Rev. Clayton Rammler, Executive Minister of our Southwest Ohio Association. This money was from the St. Peter's "Tornado Relief" offering received on Easter and the following Sunday. Some of you may recall the 1974 Tornado Outbreak. On April 3-4, 1974 there was a historic "Super Outbreak" that produced more than 100 tornados in a 24-hour period. In fact, 148 confirmed tornados occurred in the U.S. and Canada, 30 of which were F4 & F5. The path of these storms stretched 2,598 miles. Xenia, Ohio was one of the hardest hit areas. Winds of 250-305 MPH leveled half the city in a matter of minutes. There were 34 fatalities and 1,150 injured. The damage there was estimated to be at least \$100 million. It is nice to know that even then we were "caring for others."
