Ponderings About St. Peter's



We have been looking at Christ's Apostles. So far, we have done Peter, John and Thomas. This Sunday we will learn a bit about Matthew who was also called Levi. The symbol for Matthew is three money bags which refer to his previous job as a tax collector. Matthew would have been of great assistance to Jesus as a skilled writer and keeper of records. Matthew is the

author of one of the most quoted Gospels although there are some who question whether he wrote it. This is also the only Gospel that uses the word "church". After the crucifixion he was an evangelist spreading "the Word" first in Judea and then into other countries. Matthew was crucified in Ethiopia on a Tau cross and then had his head severed with a battle-axe.
