

Ponderings About St. Peter's

This is the third in our series of interviews conducted by the Confirmation class of 1987. Although this tape was difficult to hear I will be sharing the high points, and it seemed that there was a lot of wisdom shared that is lost to us but hopefully benefited Matt. These are the highlights of Matt Standen's interview with Helen Hollstein.

Helen was confirmed in 1931 and had 18 members in her class. She recalled having to do a lot of memorizing and filling out answers to questions that were in her catechism book. She brought the book and the notebook she made for class for Matt to see. Some of their lessons involved learning the 10 Commandments and what they meant, and memorizing Bible verses. Confirmation classes were two hours long. After the Confirmation service they had a formal picture taken. Helen's advice to this young man was to remember to read your Bible and to pray daily. You can never know enough about religion.
