Ponderings About St. Peter's

Here is another interview of a church member fulfilling a requirement for confirmation in 1987. This is an interview with Walter Mischka by Jason Gasser.

Walter recalled that he began attending St. Peter's in 1909 when he was three years old. His family has been members for over 100 years. As a youngster he was required to attend church every Sunday, but the services were in German, and he had little understanding of what was being said by the minister. He said he went to Sunday School more than church. His Confirmation classes lasted for two years and were led by Rev. Egli. On Confirmation Sunday each member had to stand in front of the congregation and answer a question. Walter commented that it made some of them look like dummies. In speaking with Jason, he said that it seemed to him that today once someone was confirmed you hardly ever saw them in church again. Walter also emphasized that it was important to attend church and that when he and his wife were in Florida they always went on Sunday.
