Ponderings About St. Peter's

Below is a summary of the 1987 interview of Oscar Zurcher by Jim Eaton. It gives us a bit different view of Confirmation classes here at St. Peter's. I don't have any information about the minister referenced in the interview.

Mr. Zurcher's family were members of St. John's Church in South Amherst. This church is one of the church's St. Peter's helped to found and at times we shared ministers. Mr. Zurcher was a member of the Confirmation Class of 1922. He remembers that he rode in a horse and buggy to get to classes on Saturday mornings. Rev. Ingram led the classes. When the kids arrived, the pastor would be sitting there smoking a pipe. Jim was told that the reverend must have had someone at the church "on his back" because he was always condemning someone he didn't like. Rev. Ingram wasn't at St. Peter's too many years. Classes were held where our kitchen is located today. He didn't go to Sunday School because he went to St. John's. He thought that the kids who attended Sunday School may have had an easier time with the required memorization.
