Ponderings About St. Peter's



The Rev. Adolph Egli served as the pastor of our church from 1913-1923. He had two sons who both entered the ministry and were installed at St. Peter's by their father. He also had four lovely daughters who not only shared their musical talents with the congregation but also performed in the community. At that time Amherst had an Opera House on the

second floor of our City Hall. On May 19, 1921, a Concert was given by the Egli Sisters Concert Co. which consisted of Miss Hulda Egli, Director: Soprano, Violin, Piano, Verse; Miss Martha Egli: Soprano and Cornet; Miss Elizabeth "Elsie" Egli: Alto and Drums; and Miss Lydia Egli: Alto, Violin and Piano. The program had two parts with a total of 18 pieces. Another concert was given under the auspices of the Brotherhood of St. Peter's Church and raised \$175. Still another concert included their brothers: Armin on the violin, and Oscar singing baritone. Their audiences were reported to be "large and appreciative". I wonder how many of us share our gifts and talents not only with our church but the community.
