Ponderings About St. Peter's



Have you ever wondered about the story behind our Altar Cross? In 1949 it was presented to St. Peters by the Mays Family to honor Thelma M. Mays (1913-1947). Thelma and her family

were lifelong members of our church. She graduated from Oberlin College in 1935. She taught French and English for 11 years at Barberton High School, Amherst High School, and at the time of her death, Elyria High School. She died of a cerebral hemorrhage and is buried at Crownhill Cemetery. When you look at the cross take a moment to think of the Mays family.
