# Ponderings about St. Peter's



This morning one of our hymns is "What a Friend we have in Jesus". Here is the story behind that hymn:

Joseph Scriven was born in Dublin, Ireland in 1819 to parents in the upper middle-class. He graduated from Trinity College and became a

teacher. On the night before his wedding, his bride-to-be accidentally drowned in the River Bann. Grief stricken he decided to change his lifestyle and immigrated to Canada. He lived a simple life in Canada giving away his clothing and possessions to those in need. He became known as the "Good Samaritan of Port Hope". Sources are unclear as to whether he lost his second fiancée to pneumonia or to a supposed friend. When his mother became ill, he wrote the words to this hymn and mailed them to her. She is probably the one who later had them published. When Joseph became ill, a friend who stopped to see him saw the paper with the words on his bedside table and asked who had written the beautiful poem. His response was: "The Lord and I did it together." Joseph Scriven drowned Rice Lake, Ontario in 1886.
