#### Ponderings about St. Peter's

When you think about the men who served as pastors during the early years of our church all spoke German and were not born in the United States. Then considering the time period and travel you know that God must have had a hand in selecting who would teach his word and lead to our congregation.

The Rev. R. Koestlin served as the pastor of St. Peter's German Evangelical Church in what was then North Amherst from 1874-1877. He was born in Metzingen, in Wurttemberg, Germany on May 22, 1845. He was the son of Dr. William and Louisa Koestlin. He attended the College of Humaniora at Stuttgard and the university of his kingdom. From 1866-1868 he served as a lieutenant in the Second Sharpshooter Battalion of Wurttemberg. Koestlin then immigrated to the U.S. landing in New York City on February 20, 1868. From there he went to Baltimore where he first worked at a newspaper and then entered the ministry in the German Protestant Church. In September 1868, he married Anna Newman and they eventually had two children: William and Freddie. Before coming to St. Peter's, he served one year in Princeton, Indiana and nine months in Lawrenceburg, Indiana. While with us we know that besides services in the church he held Sunday evening services in his home on Church Street. After his three years with us he moved to Middletown, Ohio and organized a new congregation and built a church.
