


Everyone is Welcome! Feel at home, for Christ lesus is our host. If you are visiting for the first time, we are delighted to have you here!

Ponderings about St. Peter's



St. Peter's has a beautiful needlepoint on one of our kneelers. This is used for weddings and can be found in a small area for meditation and praver at the bottom of the stairs

from the narthex to Fellowship Hall. In looking for someone to replicate this work, I have discovered who originally shared their time and talent to create it for the church. Many of you may remember Ruth Alice Zilch Kane. She lived in Amherst for over 80 years before moving to South Carolina to be near her daughter. Ruth was an active member of St. Peter's for almost 60 years. She was a member of our choir and often sang soprano solos; Circle Six; Altar Guild; and Prayer Group. Ruth graduated from Amherst High School in 1931 and attended Ohio Wesleyan and Oberlin College majoring in French and Music. She met and married Myron Earle Kane in 1935 and they were married for over 60 years. She graduated from Baldwin-Wallace College in 1961 with a degree in Elementary Education and was a 5th grade teacher for Amherst Schools for 17 years. Ruth died in 2010 and is buried at Brownhelm Cemetery.
