**RED** – pagans believed this color would ward off evil spirits and bring good luck – as Christians we think it symbolizes the Blood of Christ and his Passion & Love

**GREEN** – the color of holly, mistletoe and the Christmas tree – we see the eternal spirit of Jesus and the color of life

**GOLD** - this color reminds us of the baby Jesus' gift from the Three Wise Men

**SILVER** – the silver star that led the Wise Men; it offers direction to all our loved ones

PURPLE - the season of Advent; royalty & magic

**BLUE** – the color of Hanukkah and the color usually associated with Mary the mother of Jesus
