

Ponderings about St. Peter’s

This week we will be celebrating Ash Wednesday, a holy day of fasting and prayer in our Christian Calendar. It marks the beginning of the seven-week period of Lent. On this day we receive ashes that are made by burning the palm leaves from the previous year’s Palm Sunday. The wearing of ashes as a sign of repentance that dates to biblical times. Originally the ashes were sprinkled on people’s heads. Now they are placed on the forehead in the sign of the cross to indicate being a follower of Jesus. The minister or priest usually says something like: “Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return”; or “Repent and believe in the Gospel.” In some places “Ashes to Go” are done where the clergy stand in public places (sidewalks, train stations, markets, etc.) and distribute ashes. There are also regional customs, for example, in Hungary if

someone didn't receive ashes you can share the blessings by rubbing foreheads together. In Iceland children pin bags of ashes on the back of an unsuspecting person and sing songs for candy.

GriefShare* is a program for those who are grieving the loss by death of a loved one. Our program began this past Thursday.


